Professional Development points requirements:

<u>Bachelor's Degree</u>	<u>Master's Degree</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 160 professional development points• Minimum 4 college credit hours• Maximum 80 points awarded locally (Maximum of <u>40</u> points for service to profession)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 120 professional development points (Maximum of <u>80</u> points for service to profession)

How does ongoing personal spiritual formation factor into license renewal?

- Ongoing personal spiritual formation is an integral part and primary expectation of Catholic school educators.
- State licensure is based on Kansas Professional Education Standards, which does not include a spiritual component.
- Beginning August 1, 2014 no religious activities will be accepted for license renewal.

What "COUNTS" for points?

- Any activity (workshop, seminar, webinar, class, etc.) completed within the current license period that directly relates to Kansas Professional Education Standards and/or yearly goals and/or specific endorsement areas on license.
- Significant training on **NEW** programs or technology

What are the Kansas Professional Education Standards?

- There are a total of 13 Professional Education Standards. These may be found on the Archdiocesan website.
- For each of the standards there are indicators for Knowledge and Performance. The indicators are not included on the Archdiocesan website, but can be found in the Regulations and Standards for Kansas Educators document on the KSDE website.

What "DOES NOT COUNT" for points?

- Anything prior to the current license period
- General school business (reviewing calendar, handbook, discipline plan, etc.)
- Setting up/updating database, gradebook, etc.
- Review and/or minimal updates of programs or technology
- Sponsorship of teams/clubs; supplemental duties
- Faculty/departmental meetings
- **Advanc-ed building work after August 1, 2016**
