- 6. How do you choose your curriculum and textbooks? Do you have a specific approach?
- 7. Do your teachers use a specific instructional strategy or method?
- 8. Can you tell me about the classes and activities you offer?
- 9. How do you foster an environment of mutual respect between students, teachers, and parents?
- 10. What is your school's approach to keeping students safe and preventing bullying?
- 11. What are your school's policies related to diversity and inclusion?
- 12. What is your school's approach to homework and testing?
