



Using Email Well

- Drive your members to action
 - Signup for something
 - Make a payment
- Listen to your community
 - Ask for responses
 - Send a survey



Excellent uses of email

- School newsletter well designed, concise, relevant, and consistent
- Last-minute reminders
- Quick parent updates
- Short-term campaign/project updates
